ABOUT MEDIA LAB



We offer skills in graphic design, animated films, film editing, programming, digital games and much more. Right now, digital projects and web based activities including cyberbullying and Artificial Intelligence are becoming more and more popular in our work.

In addition, we offer workstations, a black and white analog photo lab and electronic equipment for rent.



Finally, Medienwerkstatt offers media education for practical and thematic media work or for cooperation in the field of media education.

WORK AND TASKS

The main role of the volunteer in this project is to prepare and implement activities for schools and youth centres, run workshops, update our social media accounts, help with some office work. However, there is ample opportunity for the volunteer's creativity, allowing them to develop their own projects.

MAIN TASKS

- Support in the preparation, carrying out of our workshops and our weekly media-pedagogical project. Own mediapedagogical projects will be supported by coworkers.
- Support in the preparation and execution of an international youth exchange in case one will be carried out through the project.
- Possibility of taking part in courses and workshops in the Media Lab.
- Documenting the projects and creating promotional material about our activities such as flyers, posters and social media content (graphic design skills and experience in Canva, InDesign or Photoshop are preferable).
- Administrative tasks concerning equipment reservations and our darkroom.

The volunteer will work 35 hours per week from Monday to Friday. The weekends are free, and the volunteers are given two days off per month, which can be saved (24 days for the whole year).

- can work independently and has a high sense of self-initiative.
- is interested in non-formal media education and pedagogy work.
